



**Monday 1 | Iraq** – Pray for the Church, which has been in Iraq since the time of Jesus' disciples, to continue to share the gospel. Pray for young people following in the footsteps of Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego from the times of Babylon (in Iraq) to give their very best to this country.

**Tuesday 2 | Vietnam** – Foom\*, a widow and mother of four, and a believer from Vietnam sustained a spinal injury after she was hit by a motorbike on her way home from church in late May this year. The man who hit her is her neighbour and the same person who beat and flogged her with a stick a few days after her conversion in 2019. Pray that Foom will continue to hold on to her faith no matter the consequences. Pray also for provision for her children. Because of her condition, she worries about their needs.

**Wednesday 3 | Cameroon** – Due to the incessant attacks by Boko Haram, many people have chosen to move into the mountains, where they have to contend with scorpions and snakes. Pray for God's provision and protection for these believers.

**Thursday 4 | Yemen** – Please pray for people who do not know the word of God. Pray for Christians to boldly and wisely communicate God's word to each person. Please pray for the sick to be healed and pray for the Yemeni church that God will bless her.

**Friday 5 | Indonesia** – Pray for the Mbojo tribe in Indonesia. Pray that ministry to this tribe will continue and God will increasingly open the way for this tribe to hear the Word of God and draw more people to Him to be saved.

**Saturday 6 | Nepal** – Tika was forced to leave her house because of her faith in Christ. Please pray that God provides her with a place to stay and fulfils her needs. Also, pray that God strengthens her faith.

**Sunday 7 | Myanmar** – Pray for the restoration of the lives of thousands of believers displaced because of the military coup. Pray for believers who have lost their homes and livelihoods that they can return home and rebuild their lives.

**Monday 8 | Bhutan** – Please continue to pray for Dorje\* who had to quit his job because of his faith. He still doesn't have a place to stay. Please pray that God provides him with a safe place to live with his family and provides for all his needs.

**Tuesday 9 | India** – Please pray for all our upcoming social-economic development and income generation programs to help strengthen persecuted Christians so they can be self-sustainable during the pandemic.

**Wednesday 10 | Brunei** – Please pray for the church in Brunei. Pray for unity amongst the believers and for a strong bond to be built amongst the various church leaders and pastors. Pray that every denomination would be united as part of one Body.



**Thursday 11 | Democratic Republic of Congo** – The Allied Democratic Forces, an extremist group, avoid crowded towns but have almost total control over vast areas in the countryside where most of the people are Christians. Pray for wisdom for pastors as they minister to their flocks in these uncertain and dangerous circumstances.

**Friday 12 | Nepal** – Full-time pastors and leaders are facing financial hardships as churches are closed because of the lockdowns. Please pray that God supplies their needs and protects their family members.

**Saturday 13 | Burkina Faso** – Thank God for the training that recently took place in the country. The participants really appreciated the training and are eager to share the knowledge with their congregations to prepare them for persecution. Pray for the Church in Burkina Faso to continue to grow.

**Sunday 14 | Burundi** – Christine\* is a Muslim background believer and mother of three. After learning of her conversion, her husband served her with a divorce certificate and abandoned the family. Christine has no other family to take her in or help her. Please pray that Christine's church will stand by her in this uncertain time and be a place of refuge for her and the children.

**Monday 15 | Arabian Peninsula** – Arab seekers and believers from a Muslim background can easily access various media platforms and materials. Unfortunately, as they search these platforms to grow in their faith, it can confuse them due to differing doctrines and interpretations of God's Word. Pray for new believers to connect with biblically grounded media sources and individuals.

**Tuesday 16 | Bangladesh** – Rubina (37) used to live in a small village in the southwest part of the country along with her husband and two daughters, but now, she has nowhere to go. Her family kicked her out for her faith. Pray for Rubina's safety and protection. In the absence of a male guardian, pray for God to be her protector and provider.

**Wednesday 17 | Tunisia** – Abel\*, a young man from Tunisia, is threatened by his friends after being too open about his faith. Pray for his protection.

**Thursday 18 | Israel & Palestine** – Pray for Jews and Palestinians in the land. The last war has left deep scars in people's hearts: scars of loss, fear and mistrust. May God restore and heal them. Pray for a long-lasting solution, based on righteousness and reconciliation.

**Friday 19 | Ivory Coast** – Please pray for Ivory Coast that has for some time now been the target of terrorism. Extremists are already in the country, particularly in the northern part. The Church can no longer hold evening services due to threats that have been received. May God take control of the situation and protect His people.

**Saturday 20 | Burundi** – Grace\* is a believer from a Muslim background and a new mother. Her husband learned of her conversion to Christianity. He now ignores any request to see his infant son. Grace feels extremely alone and abandoned and is uncertain about her future and how she will take care of her son. Please pray that God will envelop her with His peace and that she will learn to trust in Him to supply all their needs.

**Sunday 21 | Algeria** – In November 2017, Algerian authorities started a campaign to close churches, using a national ordinance that stipulates that permission must be obtained before using a building for non-Muslim worship. Another three churches in the Oran area in Algeria were sealed recently. Please pray for the churches to receive permission to re-open soon. Also pray that the pastors and leaders will know the peace of Jesus, the wisdom of the Father and the guidance of the Holy Spirit in dealing with this situation.

**Monday 22 | Central Asia** – Please pray for the protection of a young Christian woman named Aysha\*. She has received many threats from local Muslims and Muslim Imams for her ministry to Muslim women. "I can't change their lives," shared Aysha, "but I can share the love of God and tell them about the hope for them in Jesus Christ".

**Tuesday 23 | Myanmar** – In northern Myanmar, three pastors were arrested and charged by one of the tribal leaders for taking part in an interfaith prayer service. The accused pastors were sent to prison by the plaintiff, a tribe leader. One of the arrested pastors is in frail health. Please pray for the immediate release of the detained pastors. Pray that the pastors will be safe and in good health and that they will be able to access legal help and aid.

**Wednesday 24 | Morocco** – Pray for Abdel\* who lost his job because of his faith. Pray that he will find a new place of employment.

**Thursday 25 | India** – Please pray for 11 Christian families expelled from their village because of their faith and who are now living in the jungle. Pray for their protection and that they soon receive help to settle back in their village.

**Friday 26 | Tanzania** – Samina\* is a new believer from a village in Tanzania. A few months ago, Samina's husband tried to kill her as she refused to return to their traditional religion. Samina was able to run away unharmed and found refuge at a fellow church member's house where she remains. Pray that God will continue to protect her and keep her safe.

**Saturday 27 | India** – Please pray for Pastor Ezra who was threatened and physically assaulted by villagers for doing evangelism and converting a widow to the Christian faith. The lady was also attacked, assaulted and beaten up. The pastor and other church members have reported the attack to the police station. Now the situation seems to be under control but the threat from the villagers remains. Please pray for the protection of the Christians in this village.

**Sunday 28 | Bhutan** – Please pray for children who are regularly attending online Sunday schools. Pray also for all the Sunday school teachers and volunteers who are helping children learn God's word every week.

**Monday 29 | Laos** – Somkhith\* (38) and Anida\* (36), and their six children, are farmers from northern Laos facing isolation and discrimination from their community after word got out that they had left their animistic and Buddhist beliefs and became Christians in 2018. Pray for God to strengthen this family so that they will stand strong in their faith and be salt and light to their community.

**Tuesday 30 | Vietnam** – Lien\* is a pastor of a small but growing church in his village. The Lord has been using Lien and his ministry in showing His grace and miracles to the sick and the poor. Through this, many have come to know Christ and have committed their lives to Him. But as their numbers increase, so does persecution. Pray that God will stop the further plans of the enemy. Pray that Lien and his church will hold on to their faith despite persecution.
